



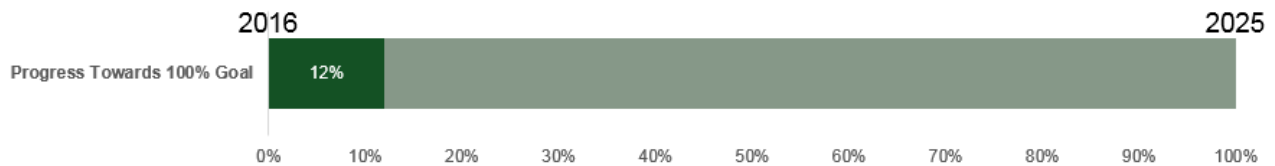
Campbell' Global Position on Cage-free Eggs

Campbell is committed to the humane treatment of animals. Animal welfare is a key part of our vision for a sustainable supply chain and is integral to our Responsible Sourcing Supplier Code. Campbell suppliers are required to implement humane procedures to prevent the mistreatment of animals at all times, including how they are raised, cared for, transported, and processed.

As we continue to advance our work with suppliers in responsible sourcing, Campbell is developing plans to transition to exclusive use of cage-free eggs in its supply chain. With our suppliers' engagement, we intend to reach that goal no later than 2025. Campbell will continue to favor suppliers that supply eggs in a timely and cost effective manner from a cage-free environment, in addition to those suppliers that can provide audit and tracking reports for sourcing cage-free eggs.

Our Progress

Campbell purchases eggs in several forms, primarily liquid and dried. Therefore, to accurately track our progress, we have converted all of our egg volumes to their liquid equivalent. We remain committed to transparency and sharing our progress. Below reflects Campbell's total cage-free volumes to-date.
